

B.S. SPORT MANAGEMENT/ M.B.A.

Students may choose to complete a B.S. in Sport Management combined with an MBA degree in as little as 5 years. Students earning a Master of Business Administration (MBA) are prepared for careers in the athletic industry. This popular and continually expanding field includes management careers at the professional, interscholastic, and intercollegiate sports levels, as well as opportunities in campus recreation, community and youth sports programs, and many more management and programming careers. The MBA emphasizes the integration of theory and practice to train current and future administrators. Professional courses focus on the most current concerns facing business administrators, including legal issues, finance, accounting, human resources, leadership, managing change, and strategic planning. The curriculum is designed to prepare individuals for the ever-changing economic, political, legal, and marketing concerns that are part of the industry.

Students will complete the learning outcomes for both the B.S. Sport Management and MBA degrees.

Academic Requirements for Major

Students are required to achieve and maintain a GPA of 3.0 in their undergraduate program in order to take graduate classes. Further, students must maintain a 3.0 in graduate classes to remain in the MBA portion of the program.
